History

The Sisters of St. Basil the Great, a religious order of the Eastern Catholic Church, was founded in the 4th century by St. Basil and his sister, St. Macrina. They established monasteries for men and women, respectively, in their native Asia Minor. The strong point of their monastic ideal was the common life and prayer.

The Uniontown Province of Our Lady of Perpetual Help had its beginning in 1921 in Cleveland, Ohio. It was there that Rev. Mother Macrina came from Philadelphia to begin a new foundation of the Order to serve the Ruthenian faithful. Initially, the small community took care of orphaned children. In 1927, the community moved to a farm in Factoryville, Pennsylvania, and then to their current home in Uniontown, Pennsylvania. The mansion on the property was dedicated as their new monastery on September 3, 1934, and named Mount St. Macrina in honor of St. Macrina.



The first Pilgrimage to the Shrine of Our Lady of Perpetual Help took place at this time. The following year Pope Pius XI presented the gift of an icon of Our Lady of Perpetual Help through Bishop Basil Takach requesting the Sisters to spread devotion to the Mother of God under this title. The Prayer League is one way that this devotion is achieved.
